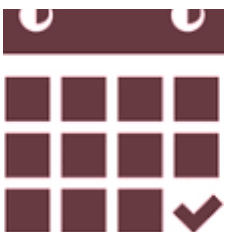


Sai Ram to all alumni & alumnae
