It was this care and affection which encouraged me and my other fellow classmates to always live up to their expectations.

Working in a social security organisation, the values such as compassion, love, affection and tolerance which I learnt in Alike, are my hallmark. The life of Tyagajeevis will always be a source of inspiration for me to work selflessly. But the ultimate thing which i always keep in my mind while working is, as Swami had told, "Hands that help are holier than the lips that pray". Thus, to conclude, each and every moment spent in Alike was so rich with memories. I will always be indebted to those Tyagajeevis for having me given a chance to learn in such a prestigious institution and in this world of uncertainty and chaos, having shown me the light success, happiness and peace.
